The Pauline Manning Award, The Mayor's Award, Louisa Letson Award, and six Honourable Mentions, will be presented at the **Opening Reception** on May 13th!

CONTEMPORARY ART SOCIETY JURIED SHOW 2011 CRITERIA

- New rule amendment to be recommended by the Executive at the April meeting That new members MUST be a member for one year <u>or</u> attend a minimum of 3 meetings - between Sept. 2010 and Apr. 2011 to be eligible to enter paintings and <u>all members</u> must have paid their yearly dues of \$30 before the April meeting to be eligible for entering any work in the show. <u>"New</u> <u>member" refers to anyone who was not a member of CAS before.</u> Membership dues <u>will not be</u> <u>accepted on the day of judging.</u>
- 2. Eligible members may submit up to 3 paintings. Works can be 84" in perimeter or smaller. If you wish to submit a work or works that are slightly larger than 84 inches perimeter length (unframed size), you are allowed only two submissions. (example > 18 inches by 24 inches = 84 inches in perimeter). Maximum perimeter of larger works = approx. 100 inches.
- **3.** Entry fee of \$5 per painting.
- **4.** <u>Only original artworks may be submitted</u>. Artwork that is derived from previously shown or published work (ie. from post cards, calendars, learn to paint books, etc.) is not allowed. Paintings done in workshops are acceptable providing the input by the instructor was minimal. Photographs may be used provided they are your own, your family's, or your friend's.
- 5. Previously shown work is acceptable only if it was shown in a non-juried show.
- **6.** Artwork must be specified as either for sale or not for sale with proper labeling applied to the back.
- 7. Paintings must be well presented and ready for hanging No wet paintings please.

JURY DAY PROCEDURES for April 16th 2011

At Fairview United Church, 3524 Dutch Village Road Drop off will be 10am - 11am Judging will be 12:00 to 4:00 Pick up 4:30- 5pm

JUDGING DAY RULES FOR APRIL 16TH:

1) Artwork Labels <u>Labels are to be placed securely on the back</u> of the painting and are <u>not to be removed until the end of the show</u>. Please complete these carefully as we will NOT BE ABLE to make changes to the labels OR PRICING at the Show. <u>Fill out 3</u> <u>duplicate Labels</u> and pass in to the person collecting them.

2) Artist Biography: Please bring an updated biography, neatly printed or typed on $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" paper. This will be included in a binder of Society Artist Biographies on display during the Show. You should also attach a copy of your biography to the back of each painting selected for the show.

3) <u>Mask out the Artist Name on your Paintings:</u> Please place a piece of masking tape over your name on the front of your artwork so that jurors do not know the identity of the artist. Remember to take it away before hanging day at the Archives!

4) <u>Drop off Paintings</u>: Bring your paintings with attached labels, submission form and biography to Fairview United Church between 10 am and 11am on April 16th.

5) Judging: Well-known artists/educators will be judging the show in the afternoon. (12:00 pm - 4:00pm)

<u>Please note*</u> Access to the art works during judging will be restricted. When you have delivered your paintings we ask your cooperation in leaving the building to allow the jurors to complete the judging.

6) <u>Pick up:</u> Please <u>return</u> to the church <u>between 4:30 and 5:00</u> pm (*no later please*) to pick up your paintings, at which time you will know if your paintings have been accepted for the show. If any of your works are accepted for the show, please volunteer at the desk for the sitter's list schedule (<u>members showing paintings will be expected to sit</u> <u>during the show</u>) AND please check with Social Convenors for your food donations to the Opening Reception on Friday May 13, 7-9 pm.

7) Best of luck and Thank you! :-)

<u>Mayor's Award *</u> Please note that the winner of the Mayor's Award is expected to have a print made up of the winning painting for presentation to the Mayor and his Office. <u>The cost for which is paid for by the</u> <u>Contemporary Art Society</u>. The Mayor's Office will <u>sometimes</u> contribute to the cost only if their budget allows - The cheque will be made out to the winner and presented along with the Award- This cheque then goes to the <u>Contemporary Art Society for payment of the print</u>. It is not a gift for the <u>winning artist to keep- it is to help pay for the print which will be framed by the</u> Mayor's Office and be honoured by display in City Hall.

Sitter Responsibilities As a sitter, you are responsible for monitoring the Exhibit Room and looking after sales. Written instructions will be provided at the time of the Show. Please make sure you arrive on time. <u>If you are unable to sit, you must find a suitable replacement- spouse or other responsible adult, and notify the Sitters' Coordinator.</u>

<u>You will be notified by phone of any sales of your artwork, and we will record the</u> <u>name, address and phone number of each buyer</u>. Because this is a juried show, <u>buyers</u> will be requested to leave their purchased paintings at the exhibition until its conclusion and to return to pick up their paintings on Saturday May 21st anytime <u>before 4:30 pm</u>. If a buyer requests special arrangements for pick up, we will accommodate, where possible, with the assistance of the artist. Payment for works will be by cash, credit card or cheque.
